

## **First Six Earn New School Risk Manager Designation**

AUSTIN, TX (April 25, 2007) – The **Certified School Risk Managers (CSRMs)** designation was conferred on six charter members of the Program in San Antonio, Texas, on April 19<sup>th</sup> at the Crowne Plaza Hotel. CSRMs, founded in 2005, is a five-course education/designation program for school risk managers and the insurance professionals who work with them; approximately 550 have participated in the program statewide to date.

The CSRMs Program is the first national education program in history for individuals acting in the capacity or role of a School Risk Manager. John Schaeffer, Treasurer of TXSRMA, along with a group of TXSRMA members and National Alliance personnel, provided the leadership and commitment to develop and launch this new education venture.
