## **First School Risk Management Course Now Online**

AUSTIN, TX (February 13, 2009) – *Fundamentals of Risk Management*, the foundational course in the **Certified School Risk Managers (CSRM) Program**, is now available online, to benefit school risk managers, employee benefits and safety coordinators, and those in human resources and positions that oversee the risk management function in schools. Insurance agents and brokers who work with school risk managers will also benefit from this online course.

Developed by The National Alliance for Insurance Education & Research, CSRM *Fundamentals* online gives an in-depth look at the overall risk management process, and examines the function of the school risk manager.

Topics include:

- Risk Management Function and Process
- The School Risk Manager
- Identifying School Risks: Logical Classifications
- Identifying School Risks: Methods
- Gathering Loss Data

The CSRM Program is an education and designation program comprised of five, one-day courses. The other four courses will also become available online during 2009. The CSRM Program originated in Texas in 2004, and because of demand for basic risk management knowledge and the Program's applicability beyond school districts, the classroom courses are now offered in 10 states, with more states being added regularly.

CSRM classroom courses are approved in many states for CE credits and it is anticipated that the online courses will also be approved in the future. The online version of *Fundamentals of Risk Management* qualifies (along with all CSRM classroom courses) as an annual update for Certified Insurance Service Representatives (CISRs).
